2.1 General Terms

"Proof of Entitlement" is the evidence of Licensee's Authorized Use of the software "Professional PA".

The software "Professional PA"" consists of:

- 1) machine-readable instructions and data
- 2) various files, including the original and all whole or partial copies
- 3) all audio-visual content
- 4) related licensed materials (such as keys and documentation)

This International License Agreement is the complete Agreement between Licensee and the

2.2 License Grants

The software "Professional PA" will be distributed exclusively via the Licensor, or distributors which are authorized by the Licensor. Support will be given exclusively by the Licensor.

The software "Professional PA" is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The software "Professional PA" is licensed and not sold.

Under this EULA the Licensor grants Licensee a <u>nonexclusive</u> license to:

providing:

Trial Version or Test License:

"Trial Version" or "Test License" means a version of the software "Professional PA", so identified, to be used only to review, demonstrate and evaluate the software "Professional PA" for a limited time period (usually 45 days). The Trial Version or Test License Version may have limited features, may lack the ability for the end-user to save the end product, and will cease operating after a predetermined amount of time due to an internal mechanism within the Trial Version or Test License.

2.3 Term and Termination

This Agreement is effective until terminated. The Licensor may terminate Licensee's license if Licensee fails to comply with the terms of this Agreement.

If the license is terminated for any reason by either party, Licensee agrees to promptly destroy all of Licensee's copies of the software "Professional PA". Any terms of this Agreement that by their nature extend beyond termination of this Agreement remain in effect until fulfilled, and apply to both parties, respective successors and assignees.

2.4 Charges and Taxes

Charges are based on Authorized Use obtained, which is specified in the Proof of Entitlement. For charges already due or paid, the Licensor does not give credits or refunds.
